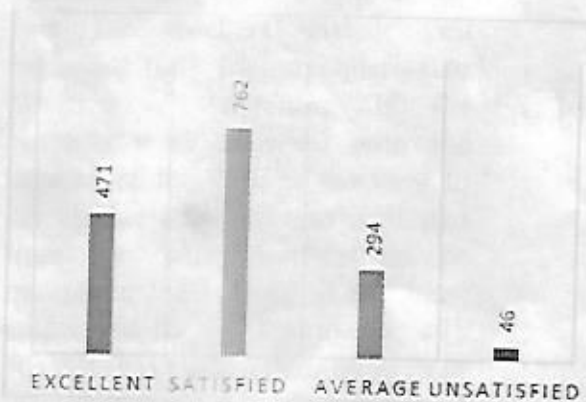
1. Are you satisfied with the infrastructure provided by the college.

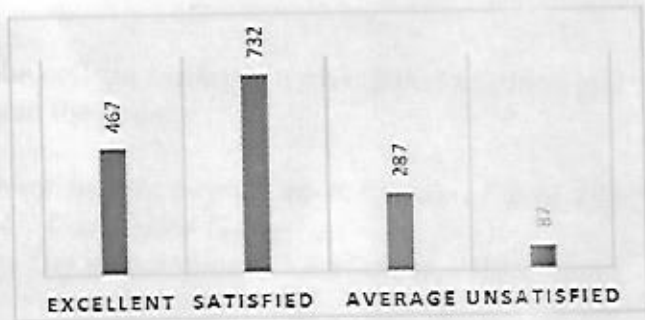
Item No. 01: Are you satisfied with the infrastructure provided by the college.

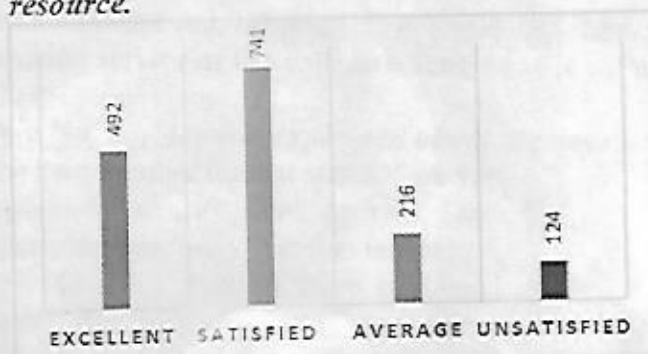


Item No. 02: Does the college provide transparency in conducting examination and declaration of results.

Item No. 03: *Does the college have adequacy, accessibility and quality of teaching learning resource.*

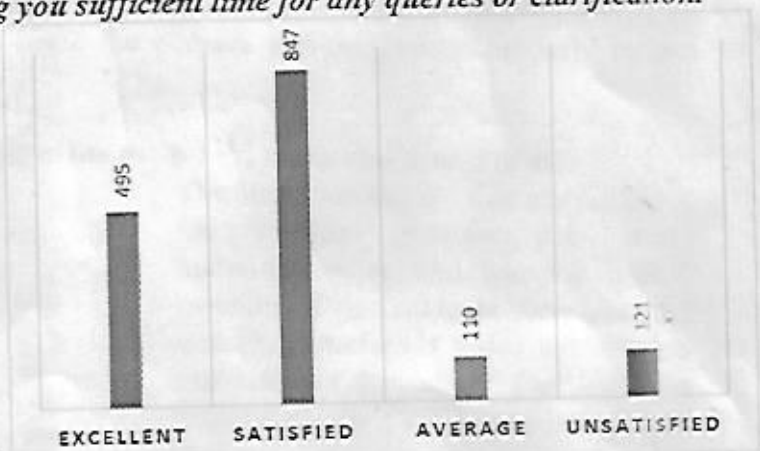

Item No. 04: *Are the teachers giving you sufficient time for any queries or clarification.*

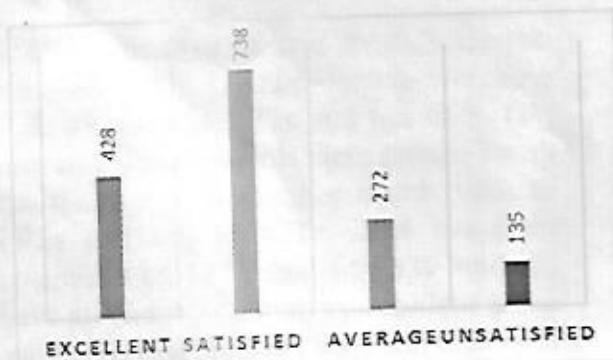

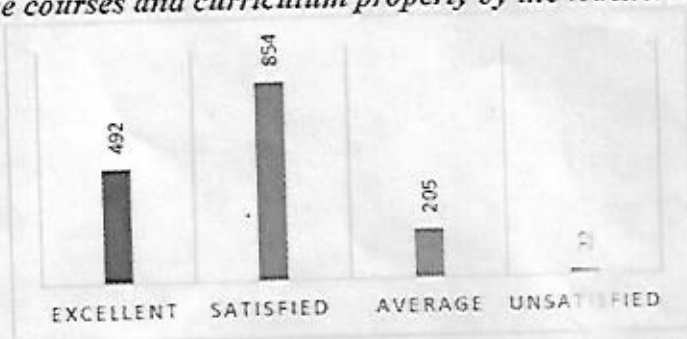

teachers classroom teaching. It is found that the maximum students have satisfaction with the teaching service of the college teachers in the college.

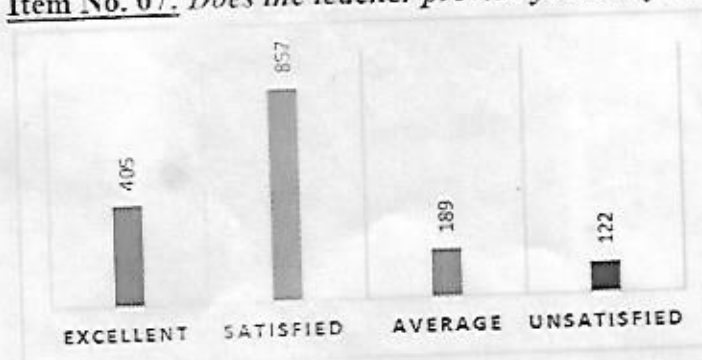
Item No. 06: *Are you explained about the courses and curriculum properly by the teachers.*

Item No. 07: *Does the teacher provide you study materials, notes and learning aids.*



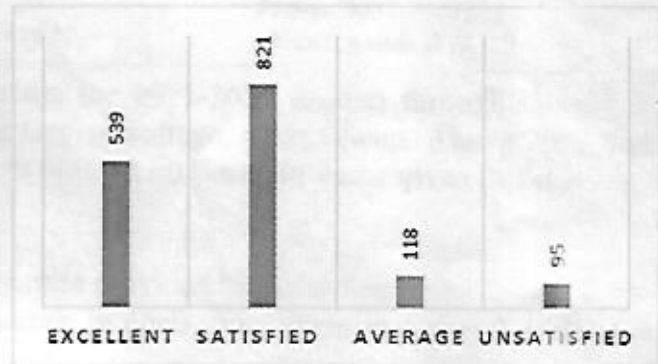
